Answer: m) Brush

-
- This tool will make a selection of an area of the image based on color and similar color values.

 - This tool is used to scroll or pan your view of an area of the image, when the entire image is not showing in the document window.

 - This tool is used to change the aspect ratio (the Width and Height relationship) of an image, allowing you to select the area of focus and area to be cut off.

 - This tool allows you to add borders or extra space around the image.

 - This tool is used to saturate (make more intense) or desaturate (make less intense) color pixels in the image.

 - This tool is used to lighten part of the image.

 - This tool is used to drag one image or layer into another image document window.

 - This tool is used to remove excess borders or perimeter parts of the image.

 - This tool is used to make a rectangular selection of the image or part of the image.

10. This tool is used to change the position of a layer or a selected part of the layer.

11. This tool may be used to Resample the image.

12. This tool is used to draw a freeform selection around an area of the image.

13. This tool is used to increase or decrease the magnification of the image on the screen.

14. Drawing with this tool will make a selection by snapping to the dividing line between areas of contrasting color.

15. This tool is used to measure the color values of a pixel.

16. When this tool is clicked on a color from within the document or image window, it will change the foreground color swatch to that color.

17. This tool will make a selection by dragging a series of straight lines around part of the image.

18. This tool is used to drag a guide line from the Rulers into the document window.

19. This tool is used to straighten a crooked image.

20. This tool is used to select and reposition guide lines in the document window.
