| <p>2. This tool is used to scroll or pan your view of an area of the image, when the entire image is not showing in the document window.</p> <p>_____</p> | <p>6. This tool is used to lighten part of the image.</p> <p>_____</p> |
| <p>3. This tool is used to change the aspect ratio (the Width and Height relationship) of an image, allowing you to select the area of focus and area to be cut off.</p> <p>_____</p> | <p>7. This tool is used to drag one image or layer into another image document window.</p> <p>_____</p> |
| <p>4. This tool allows you to add borders or extra space around the image.</p> <p>_____</p> | <p>8. This tool is used to remove excess borders or perimeter parts of the image canvas.</p> <p>_____</p> |

- 10.** This tool is used to change the position of a layer or a selected part of the layer.

- 11.** This tool may be used to Resample the image.

- 12.** This tool is used to add horizontal text to the image.

- 13.** This tool is used to increase or decrease the magnification of the image on the screen.

- 14.** Drawing with this tool will make a selection by snapping anchor points to the dividing line between areas of contrasting color.

- 15.** This tool is used to measure the color values of a pixel.

- 16.** When this tool is clicked on a color from within the document or image window, it will change the foreground color swatch to that color.

- 17.** This tool uses an option of Tolerance Amount to determine how many shades of color it will put a selection around.

- 18.** Clicking this tool will remove contiguous areas of similar color.

- 19.** This tool is used to straighten a crooked image.

- 20.** Double-clicking on this tool will “Fit Image to Screen.”
