

This is the type for the movie poster, Mandatory Lesson 2 (page 18-22, Classic Photoshop Effects by Scott Kelby). After working with this block of text on the poster, you'll soon see why your file needs to be at least 216 ppi and *not* 72 ppi!

Remember if you don't have Helvetica Neue Condensed, look for a similar **sans serif condensed** font. The movie credit type is All Caps and the ratio between the large and small type is approximately 1.5. For example if your small type is 12 pt, multiply that by 1.5 to find the point size for the larger type (18 pt)

Don't forget to add the Rating box and the Paramount Logo. Just look at a DVD cover to get an idea...or google and copy one from the internet. Paramount Pictures would be a good place to start.
